

LITTLEWOOD VENDOR SPACE 2008 RULES & REGULATIONS

1. No one may use any electrical outlet to connect any cord or appliance that does not meet local code and such item may be removed without claim for damages.
2. No speeding in, on or around the facility. Care of horses and riders must be taken at all times.
3. Golf carts may be driven only by licensed drivers. If Littlewood issues I.D. passes to golf carts or other conveyances, only properly permitted conveyances will be allowed.
4. Van and trailer parking is by permit and permit number must be displayed on vehicle at all times. Permit is included at no additional charge.
5. All vehicles must be driven at slow, safe speeds.
6. No noise that disturbs any neighbor will be allowed.
7. No nuisance of any kind will be allowed. This includes parties, drunken or rude behavior, fights, horns, loud engines, barking-biting-dangerous dogs, etc. Common courtesy is expected from and toward all customers and fellow vendors. Anyone that is deemed a nuisance may be expelled from the property at any time without refund. The decision of management is final.
8. No substitution of vendor without approval of management.
9. Waste must be placed in designated container areas only.
10. All used areas must be kept clean and neat at all times.
11. Failure of any person to follow these rules and regulations may result in the loss of use of the area and the removal of all units, supplies, etc. relating to said person without refund or claim for damages.
12. All areas of the property must be used properly and for the intended purpose.
13. Parking areas for carts, bikes and vehicles must be properly observed and any reserved area must be used only by the proper person.
14. Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Failure to comply with this rule is subject to penalty.
15. Deliveries must be cleared by the office as to times and placement.
16. No vendor space or parking space may be used until agreement is properly completed, required insurance certificate and Wellington occupational license received and payment is made.
17. Any nonnegotiable fees for these uses will result in an increase in the fee of \$50 and will terminate use immediately until the fee is paid with cash or certified funds. All funds are U.S. funds only.
18. User is responsible for any damage to facility.
19. Vendor agrees to operate between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. only.
20. No public address announcement may be made without permission from management.
21. All signage and/or banners must be maintained in the area assigned and may not disrupt the show rings in any way.
